

# 2020 4-Wheel Jamboree Nationals- Lima, OH

## CAMPING FAQ's

### **Q) What do I need to bring when I check-in?**

Campers must bring a valid driver's license and current Street Machine Nationals exhibitor or participant credentials in order to check-in to campsite. Campers **MUST PICK UP CREDENTIALS AT REGISTRATION or EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN** prior to campgrounds check-in & show proof of being a registered exhibitor / participant.

### **Q) If I reserve a spot, do I get to choose my campsite?**

No, all spots are assigned internally on a first come, first serve basis.

### **Q) Which campground is available?**

4-Wheel Jamboree camping is available in the Allen County Fairgrounds' North Campgrounds entrance at Gate 1 off of SR 309, proceed along Marion Road to campground.

### **Q) Do all sites have power?**

Most of the sites in the north campgrounds do have power, however, some tent sites do not have power. 20 amp service is provided.

### **Q) Can I use a generator?**

No. Generators are not permitted in the campgrounds in order to keep noise levels to a minimum.

### **Q) Do I need to be a registered Street Machine Nationals exhibitor or participant to camp?**

YES - the campground is only open to registered Street Machine Nationals participants as well as exhibitors/vendors. Campers will be required to show event credentials before entering the campground.

### **Q) Do I need to be a registered 4-Wheel Jamboree exhibitor or participant to camp?**

YES - the campground is only open to registered 4-Wheel Jamboree participants as well as exhibitors/vendors. Campers will be required to show event credentials before entering the campground.

### **Q) Is there a size limit for campers?**

Yes, the North Campground has a size limitation of 35' (this size is dictated by the State Fairgrounds).

### **Q) Can I park my car in my camp spot?**

We cannot guarantee that your car will fit on any given site. Small tent sites, depending on the arrangement, will not be allowed to park their cars with the exhaust pointing towards the tent, this is a safety issue.

### **Q) Can I bring my car trailer into the campgrounds?**

Car trailers, cargo trailers and car dollies are not allowed in the campground.

**Q) What are Camping Check-In Hours:** Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup> : Noon - 6:00 pm and Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>: 8:00 am - 2:00 pm. All camping units must be in the campgrounds by 2:00 pm CT Friday at the latest.

### **Q) Can I park my camper on Saturday?**

No, all camping units must be in the campgrounds by Friday, **there will not be any campers parked after 2:00 on Friday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>.**
